WHAT ARE THE SPIRITUAL GIFTS?


Twenty-two spiritual gifts are referenced in the New Testament in the writings of the Apostle Paul.

The gifts listed in the italicized text above were not reflected in the survey.

Some spiritual gifts are easily detected, for example the gift of healing. If people are frequently healed from illnesses when an individual prays for them, it is likely that they have the gift of healing. Other gifts are less obvious and require a more in-depth look.

The purpose of a spiritual gifts survey is to take an in-depth look at what characteristics are likely to match the description of a particular spiritual gift. It is important to remember that the most reliable indicator of a spiritual gift is the affirmation of these personal characteristics by others.
